## Coaching Staff



The Otterbein baseball program, under tenth-year head coach George Powell, won the OAC Championship for the third straight year and advanced to the NCAA Division III Tournament for the fourth time in the past five years. Powell has been selected OAC Coach of the year three times in his short career and has led the Cardinals to a top 20 ranking in the ABCA National Poll in each of the last three seasons. In 2006, his Cardinal team set the school record for victories (34) and advanced to the NCAA Regional final game for the third time in four years. In 2007, Coach Powell reached the 200th win plateau with a victory over John Carroll.



Dave Ewing begins his 18th season as pitching coach at Otterbein College. A 1962 Otterbein graduate, Ewing served as head baseball coach at Walnut Ridge for 12 years, compiling over 200 wins and leading his teams to four city league championships and one district championship. In 1999, he was inducted into the Ohio High School Baseball Coaches Hall of Fame.



Brian Meyer is in his 3rd year as Graduate Assistant Coach. Meyer, a 2004 graduate, was a three year starter for the Cardinals and helped them capture their first OAC tournament in 14 years in 2003.
