His Westerville home was a station on the Underground Railroad and is now on the National Register of Historic Places. Hanby's son Benjamin composed familiar songs Darling Nelly Gray and Up on the Housetop. Located a block from Otterbein College, Hanby House is presently operated by the Westerville Historical Society and contains period furnishings and a large collection of sheet music.
