Eta Phi Mu

The Eta Phi Mu Alumni Association is pleased to announce that the extensive interior renovation of the Jonda House has gotten off to a terrific start. In order to save potentially \$20,000.00 on the project costs, numerous volunteer alumni members have spent the last six weeks demolishing the interior of the House, ripping out all drywall, plaster, woodwork and fixtures, leaving just the studs of the structure, so as to facilitate the complete overhaul of the electrical, plumbing and HVAC systems. Demolition is approximate 85% complete. Upon completion of the demolition, the estimated \$120,000.00 interior renovation will begin in earnest with professional contractors expected to complete the project by Spring 2008. While financing for the project is tentatively lender approved, the Alumni's 30/360 donation drive will provide interim financing for expenses such as taxes, insurance, and utilities. The goal of the 30/360 drive is to get 50 Jonda Alumni to donate \$30 per month for 12 months (or \$360) to cover these expenses while the House is vacant. The Alumni proudly announce that so far 40 members have made the pledge.
