

Fee Selected to ESPN The Magazine Academic Team in Women's Basketball

Sara Fee, a senior from Bryan, Ohio, was named to the 2008 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District IV first team in women's basketball as selected by the College Sports Information Director's of America (CoSIDA), released Thursday, Feb. 7 by CoSIDA.

Fee, who earned second team academic all-district honors as a sophomore and junior, is now eligible for Academic All-America consideration. A three-year starter at guard, Fee is majoring in nursing and has made the Otterbein Dean's List all 10 quarters. Fee, who is averaging 11.2 points and 4.7 rebounds a game, has scored in double digits over the last four games. She has 967 points in her career. The senior guard ranks second in the Ohio Athletic Conference for shooting accuracy, making 86 of 145 field-goal attempts for 59.3 percent.

Academic All-District IV team members are selected through voting by CoSIDA, a 2,000-member organization consisting of sports public relations professionals for colleges and universities in the United States and Canada. District IV encompasses the states of Alabama, Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio and Tennessee.

To be eligible, a student-athlete must be a varsity starter or key reserve, maintain a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.20 on a scale of 4.00, have reached sophomore athletic and academic standing at his/her current institution and be nominated by his/her sports information director
