

Otterbein College Football ^{3rd} Annual 7 on 7 Passing Competition

SATURDAY – July 18 & 25, 2009

10:00 AM-4:00 PM

Otterbein College * Westerville, Ohio

Fee: \$80 for one team; \$120 for two teams. Each team will be guaranteed four games.

Facilities: Otterbein College Game and Practice Fields. Can hold up to 10 games at one time!

Method of Play:

1. Each Game will be 35 minutes running time.
2. Coin flip determines team to start on offense.
3. Ball will always start on the offense's 40-yard line to start a possession. Includes interceptions.
4. Offense will be given 4 downs to make a first down (20 yards).
5. Offense has 25 seconds to put ball in play.
6. **SCORING:** All touchdowns are **6 pts**. PAT from the 5 yd. Line is worth **1 pt**. PAT from the 10 yd. Line is worth **2 pts**. Interceptions ran back for Touchdown worth **6 pts**. Interceptions on PAT become a dead ball.
7. Offenses may finish a drive started before time has expired only if they have a chance to tie or win.
8. Team with the most points at the expiration of time wins.
9. Ties will be played off immediately by method of sudden death overtime. Each team will be given 4 plays from the 25-yard line with PAT. Two overtime limit until Bracket Play rounds.

Governing Rules:

1. This is a 7 on 7 Passing Tournament.
2. No running plays (QB may not run the football).
3. No blocking what so ever. Blocking will constitute a loss of down penalty.
4. Offenses may have 5 eligible receivers, plus QB and Center.
5. The football must be thrown within 4.0 seconds. If not, it is considered a sack, play the next down from the previous line of scrimmage.
6. Penalties:
 - 5 Yard Penalty and Loss of Down**
 - A. Offensive Pass Interference
 - B. Blocking
 - 5 Yard Penalty and Repeat Down**
 - A. Offensive or Defensive Off Sides
 - B. Defensive Holding or Illegal Bumps
 - C. Defensive Pass Interference (Automatic first down if in the end zone).
7. Defenders may "Bump" receivers only once within 5 yards of the LOS. Must be below the neck.
8. Defenders must "Touch" receivers with one hand to down the play below the neck.
9. All fumbles that touch the ground are dead (offense retains possession).
10. Any flagrant foul can result in disqualification for the game or day.
11. Coaches must stay out of the secondary.
