SURVEY OF GRADUATE ALUMNI 2015

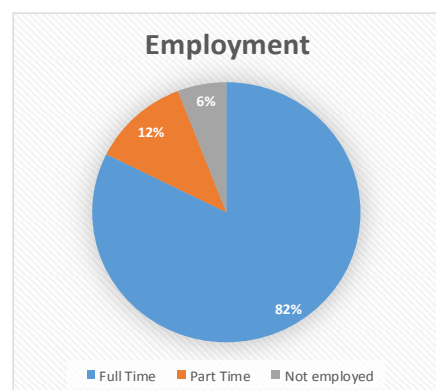
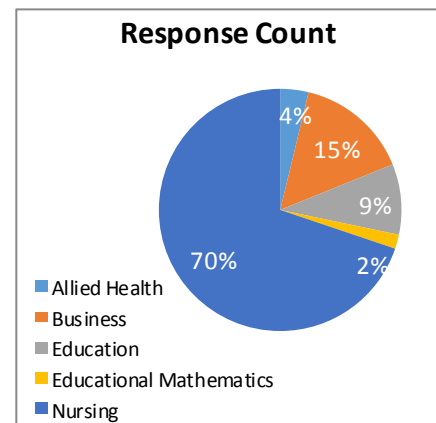
The Graduate School New Alumni Survey was conducted in the summer of 2015. Respondents (graduates from summer 2014 through spring 2015) reflected on their time and experiences at Otterbein and about their current careers. There was a 49.5% response rate.



IMMEDIATE EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY (4 MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION)

Otterbein graduates get jobs!
Ninety– four percent of the graduates indicated that they were currently employed.

- ⇒ (84%) indicated that their job was in their chosen profession.
- ⇒ (82%) are working full-time.
- ⇒ (70%) obtained a new position since earning their graduate degree at Otterbein University.





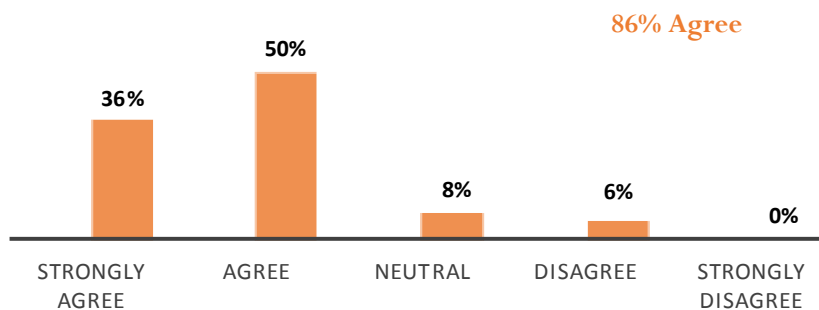

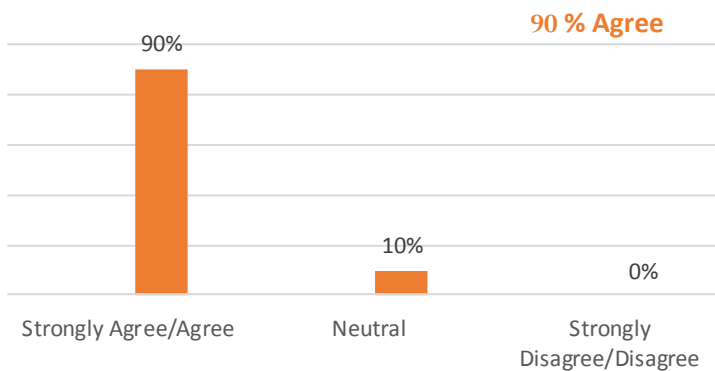

knowledge in their disciplines

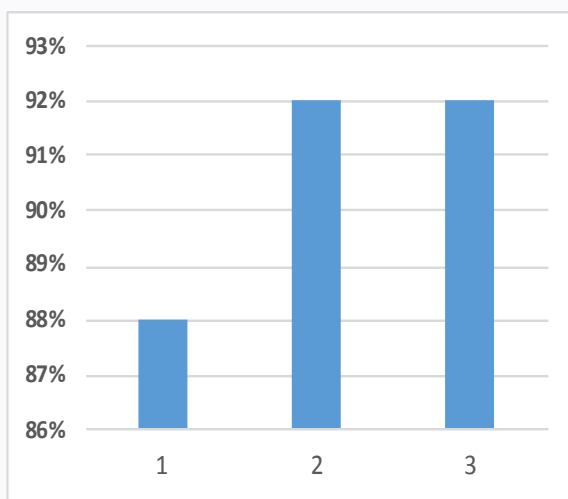


Graduates are overwhelmingly positive about their learning at Otterbein.

3. 92% agree or strongly agree that Otterbein's curriculum helped them to address the values and ethics critical in their field of practice.



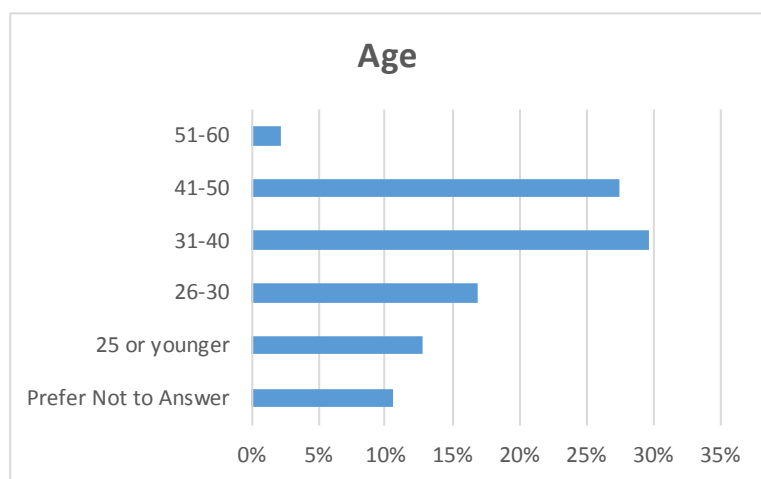
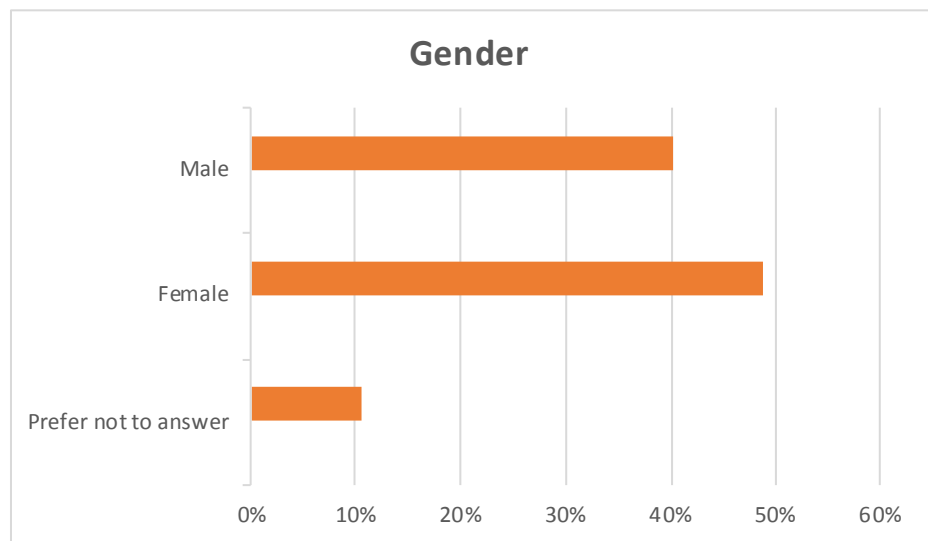
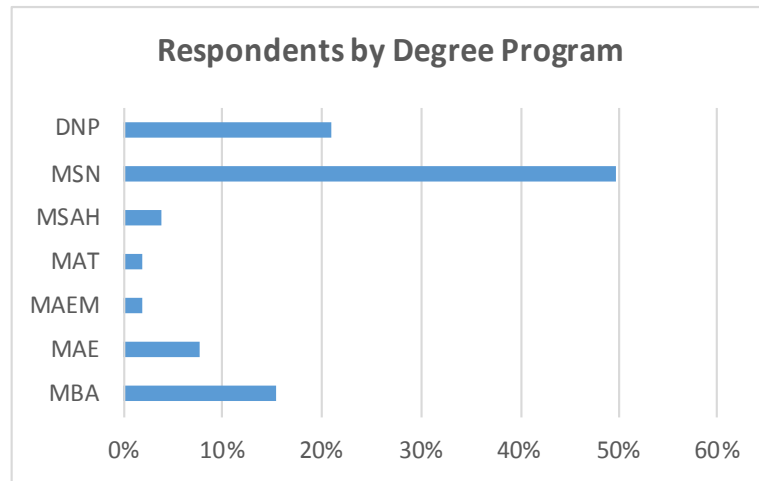

WHO GRADUATED?



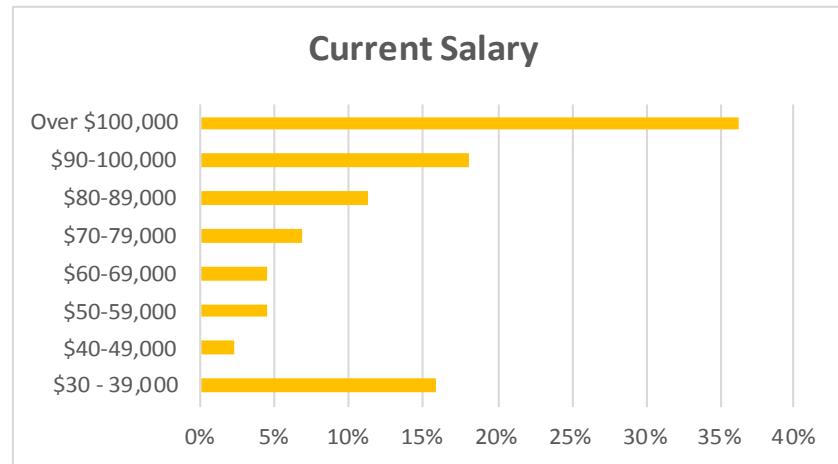
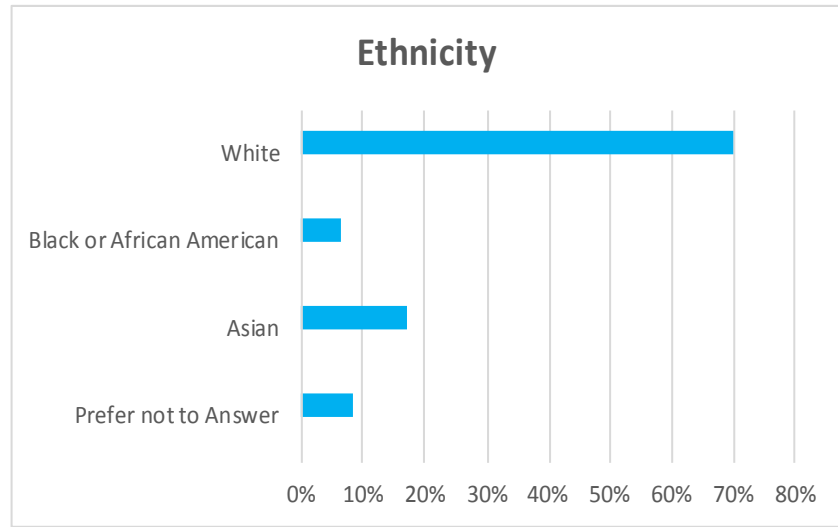
