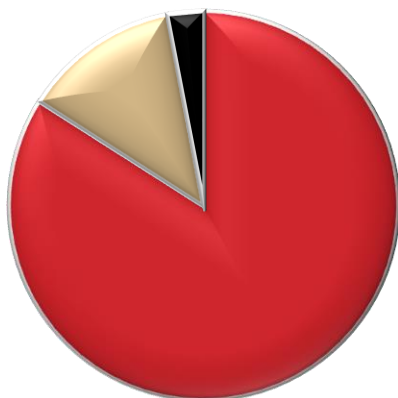




Class of 2017 Undergraduate Outcomes

Institutional Research and the Center for Career & Professional Development (CCPD) partner each year to collect data on the outcomes of our undergraduate students. An electronic survey was launched in late 2017 and additional research was conducted by CCPD staff and faculty and staff from a variety of academic departments through the end of January 2018.

We are pleased to share that an 84% knowledge rate was achieved, which is a combination of survey responses by recent graduates and additional information collected through social media by Otterbein staff and faculty. This research reveals that 97% of the undergraduate class of 2017 was either employed or enrolled in graduate school within six months of graduation. When we disaggregate the employed/enrolled in graduate school data, you'll find that 84% are employed and 13% are enrolled in graduate school. This is the third year in a row that at least 96% of the undergraduate class has been employed or in graduate school within six months of graduation.
