Equine Business Management Minor

The Equine Business Management Minor offers students the unique opportunity to expand their equine business knowledge while studying a different major. Students are immersed in an intensively horse-centered curriculum that allows students to broaden their horsemanship skills and develop a working knowledge of the equine industry. Students have the option to choose hands-on equine activities or focus on the business applications involving horses.

Residency Requirements

In order to graduate from any university a student should take a significant portion of the hours for his or her program of study from that university, take a significant proportion of hours in the major from that university, and take a significant proportion of the “signature elements” of that university’s general education requirements.
