Electrical Appliances – Please use extreme care when selecting electrical appliances. Remember the space limitations of many areas and the number of outlets available. Share as many items with roommates as possible and to consider if you need to bring items such as microwaves, when one is available within the residence hall lounge areas. All items must be UL approved. **Avoid ionic hair implements** as they set off fire alarms when used in rooms. You may bring the following items into the residence halls: power strips with circuit breakers, TVs, video game systems, computers, razors, clocks, fans, air purifiers, curling irons, hair dryers, refrigerators (under 4 cubic ft.) and compact microwaves (800 watts or less). Furniture - All rooms are furnished with a bed & mattress (XL twin), desk, chair, and closet/drawer space for each student. Beds may be bunked in all halls and lofted with a stabilizer bar in all halls (except Mayne). You are responsible for use and care of University property and are expected to pay for replacement/repair of any items damaged during the year. You must keep all University provided furniture in your room throughout the year, and may not store or remove furniture. You are expected to leave your room in clean, move-in condition, when you move out.
